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Role of Bifonazole in Keratomycosis

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A study of 10 cases of fungal Keratitis was carried out. The role of 1 % eifonazole as topical antifungal agent was studied. Dermatological preparation of eifonazole (mycospor) was used. The disease was more common in fifth decade of life and was more frequent in males. The condition was unilateral in 100% of cases. Trauma was the main triggering factor. Topical Bifonazole in 1 % concentration was found to be an effective drug to treat the disease.
